Moving on to multi-tasking. You may be used to using several programs at the same time on your computer, which is known as multi-tasking. On the iPad, multi-tasking works a bit differently. Although you can use several apps at the same time, you can easily switch between apps without going to the Home Screen. For example, you might be browsing the Web in Safari and then decide to send a message through the Mail app. To make multi-tasking as seamless as possible your iPad will keep recent apps paused in the background. When you switch to a recent app, you won't have to wait for it to load- you simply pick up where you left off. To switch between apps quickly press the home button two times. A preview of current apps will appear. You can swipe left or right to browse through the current apps. Simply tap an app to open it.
